MY NUMBER MESSAGE CARD

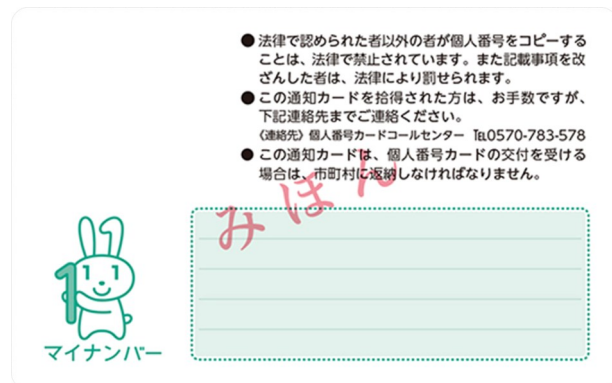
Beginning in October and running through November, "My Number" message cards will be distributed to everyone in the country. The address they will be sent to is the one listed on your Certificate of Residence. The message card will be sent by simple registered mail. Mailing for Seika starts at the beginning of November.

In principle, from birth numbers will not change, so please take care of it. Also, if you lose your card, it will take time to have a new one distributed to you, so please make sure not to accidentally throw it away!

"My Number" will be used on the national and local level for purposes related to the fields of Social Security, Taxes and Disaster Response. Pension, Work Insurance, and Health Insurance, as well as Public Welfare, Childcare Allowances, other Welfare services, and Tax will use "My Number". Now, when you require information from the town office, you will no longer be required to show your Certificate of Residence or your Tax Declaration Certificate to receive it. In the future, you will be able to complete some procedures without having to go to the Town Office.

Your Privacy Will Be Handled Securely

Under the "My Number" program your personal information will not be managed in the same location as your "My Number". For example, information related to Federal Tax is only handled by the Tax Office, information related to Childcare Allowances and Public Welfare is only handled by the Town Office and information related to National Pension will only be handled by the National Pension Office, so personal information will still be handled separately, just as it has been up until now.

Using “My Number” in Your Workplace

Some private offices such as Social Healthcare and Income Tax offices may need access to your “My Number”. For this purpose you may need to provide your “My Number” at your place of employment, brokerage firm, or banking facility.

However, you will never need to provide your “My Number” to a company you do not know. Your “My Number” could be used for illegal purposes, so never share it with a company or person you do not know.
