EMERGENCY MEDICAL	4	[Things to Bring] On the pick up date, please bring with you the following items. ① Your Distribution notice (交付通知書, <i>Koufu Tsuchishō</i>) ② Your Notification Card (通知カード, <i>Tsuchi Kādo</i>) ③ Citizen Identification Card (住民基本台帳カード, <i>Juumin Kihon Daichou Kādo</i>) ④ Another form of Personal Identification (Please bring one of the following: Driver's License, Driver's History Form (If received after April 1st, 2012), Passport, A Citizen's Identification Card (With Picture), Physical Handicap Booklet, Mental Handicap Health and Welfare Booklet, Rehabilitation Booklet, Foreigner Registration Card, Special Resident Certificate, Temporary Asylum Permission Form, or a Temporary Stay Permission Form. ※ For those who do not have at least one of the documents listed above, please bring two items from the following list: Health Insurance Certificate, Pension Booklet, Employee Card, Student Card, an official document listing your school's name, a bank book, or a Medical Payment Certificate.)

Please do not register easy strings of numbers or personal numbers like your birthday. Please think of what number you will use before arriving. ① Personal Electronic Signature - Between 6 and 16 letter and numbers (Cannot be all letters or numbers) ② User Pin Number - 4 letters ※ Two more Pin Numbers will be required, but they can be the same as ②. ※ ① and ② from above will be included on the My Number card. ① is primarily for making electronic documents and sending them online. ② is primarily for logging into the website. It can be used for internet banking or logging in at a convenience store.

CYCLE RACE ON MAY 30TH (MON) IN SEIKA

The UCI Official International Cycling Road Race "19th Tour of Japan - Kyoto Stage" will be held on May 30th (Mon) on a course that extends into Kyotanabe and Seika.

The race is Asia's largest and highest level cycling road race and will be bustling with attendees. It is hoped to be a good source of promotion both domestically and internationally for the Kansai Science City and the southern region of Kyoto.

Beginning with information on Road Traffic Control, details will be available in this newsletter in coming editions. This may cause some difficulty for those living near the course, but we appreciate your cooperation.

Before the start of the event, there will be a ceremony run on a course that connects *Fugenji Fureai no Eki and Doshisha University in Kyotanabe City, starting at 9:25 AM.*

The race will begin at 9:50 Am in front of Fugenji Elementary School. The heated competition will take place on a 16.8 km course that passes through the area surrounding Keihanna Plaza 6.5 times for a total of 107 km. The final goal is the Panasonic Research Facility (Hikaridai 3-chome), and the race is expected to end around 12:40 PM.

NEW HEALTH INSURANCE CARDS WILL BE SENT OUT THIS MONTH

For families enrolled in National Health Insurance

Families enrolled in National Health Insurance (*Kokuho*) will receive new National Health Insurance Cards in the mail that can be used as soon as April of this year. Once your documents have arrived, confirm the contents, and if there are errors in the address, name or another section please contact the National Health Insurance division in the town office as soon as possible. Your new Health Insurance cards will be good until March 31st, 2018.

For families enrolled in National Health Insurance

New Health Insurance cards will be sent out during this month, and all cards for a family will be sent to the head of the household. If the head of the household is not enrolled in National Health Insurance, then it will be sent to their address.

It will be sent by Simple Registered Mail, so in the event that no one is at home you will receive a Notice of Delivery. In that case, please contact the post office and request a re-delivery.
