MY NUMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

Below is some information about applying for a My Number Card during Seika Matsuri, the My Number Holiday Reception Counter, and the extension of convenience store distribution services.

Applying for My Number at Seika Matsuri (Sunday, Nov. 20)

We will have a special My Number Card Application booth at Keihanna Plaza during Seika Matsuri (November 20, Sunday). Please make sure to bring your personal number card distribution application form because the My Number Card application ID is necessary to complete this process. We will also take and print ID pictures for the My Number Card application even if you are not applying for a My Number Card that day.
 ※These services are only available to registered residents in Seika Town.
 ※The first 300 people to come by the booth will receive original Maina-chan goods!

My Number Holiday Reception Counter

On November 13 (Sunday) and November 27 (Sunday) from 9AM-12PM and 1PM-4:30PM, there will be a holiday reception counter for My Number Card applications at the My Number Card special reception counter on the second floor of Seika Town Hall. This is only for those who have received the My Number notification card. A reservation is required.

※Please call or e-mail the General Services Division between 8:30 AM to 5:15PM on weekdays. If making a reservation by e-mail, please include the names of everyone coming to receive this service, date of birth, address, daytime telephone number, the number written on the upper-left side of the My Number postcard's backside, and your desired appointment day and time (up to three choices) in the e-mail. Appointments take approximately 15 minutes per person.

PROTECTING YOUR INFORMATION FROM OTHERS

When Reporting Domestic Violence, Child Abuse, and Other Similar Crimes

As part of our support measures, Seika Town Hall promises to protect your information from others in the event of reported acts of domestic violence, child abuse, and stalkers. Upon applying to Seika Town Hall, we can guarantee that your new address and other personal information will be protected for one year (extending this period is also possible). Attach a copy of your driver's license or something else to confirm your identity and submit this to the General Services Counter on the second floor of Town Hall. After applying, we will confirm with the police and other related agencies, and if support is deemed necessary, we will not accept requests from the perpetrator of these crimes or any other third party to see any sort of residency records. We also, as a general rule, will not accept any sort of mailed requests or enquiries from people claiming to be representatives for parties involved. Please contact the General Services Counter with any questions. Applications are available on the town homepage as well as at the General Services Counter and the Kizu Police Station.
