

\*Items that cannot be disposed of: Business waste (waste from restaurants, construction, offices or any other waste produced from business activities), tires, car batteries, used oil, fire extinguishers, paint, fertilizers, mulch/weed growth prevention sheets, chemicals, construction waste materials, extremely large or heavy items, recyclable home appliances (air conditioners, televisions, refrigerators, and washing/drying machines), cement blocks, dirt, etc.

\*Scrap material and waste from home improvement projects, car maintenance, large tree and yard waste are considered construction or commercial waste and must be disposed of accordingly, as they do not meet the criteria of acceptable waste for garbage collection.


