National Pension Basics

The National Pension System of Japan was established as a social safety net that everyone contributes toward to support the lives of the elderly, people who have incurred a disability due to an accident or other incident, or families who has lost the main earner in their household. People between the age of 20-60 that live in Japan are beneficiaries of National Pension, and are classified under Category 1. Category 1 beneficiaries are required to pay pension fees every month.



However, if you have low income and are unable to pay the fee before the deadline, you may qualify for a deduction or full exemption from payments through programs such as the Special National Pension Payment System for Students (gakusei noufu tokurei seido), or National Pension Payment Postponement or Exemption (menjo noufu yuuyo seido).

The 3 Types of National Pension Benefits

National Pension is often mistaken as being only beneficial to the elderly, when in fact, nonelderly can receive benefits from National Pension as well.

Elderly Pension

This benefit is available to people aged 65 and older, and can be received until the end of their life. This is the most common type of benefit people think about regarding National Pension.

Disability Pension

This benefit is available to people who have incurred a disability from a sickness or injury. The amount of benefit received depends on the severity of the disability.

Survivors' Pension

This benefit is available to the dependent children or spouse of a family in the event the main earner of the household dies.

Discontinuance of Pension Booklets Starting April

The National Pension System of Japan assigns a Basic Pension Number to all enrollees that contains pension related information such as enrollment date and pension fee payment status. This number is recorded in the blue National Pension booklet distributed to each enrollee, but, due to the introduction of the MyNumber system, the booklets have been deemed unnecessary and will thus be discontinued.

Starting this April, beneficiaries of Categories 1, 2, and 3 will be sent a Basic Pension Number Notification (kiso nenkin bangou tsuuchi-sho) instead of a pension booklet. This notification will be necessary for any pension related procedures, so be sure to keep it in a secure place. The pension booklet may still be used as a form of Basic Pension Number confirmation. Should your pension booklet become lost, you will be issued a Basic Pension Number Notification instead of a new pension booklet.

Coronavirus Vaccination Information



Update on Third Round of Coronavirus Vaccination

People who have already received the full coronavirus vaccination schedule (two shots) 8 or more months ago will be eligible for the third coronavirus vaccine booster shot. Seika Town is preparing to send out vaccination vouchers to eligible people, and will start holding group vaccination drives in March.

Dried shrimp · · · · 6g Oyster sauce · · · · 7g

Instructions

- 1. Wash mochi rice and let it soak for 30 minutes.
- 2. Reconstitute dried shiitake and shrimp. Be sure to save the water.
- 3. Cut shiitake, shrimp, carrots, and fried pork into 1cm pieces.
- 4. Drain mochi rice, add water from reconstitution, regular water, cut ingredients, and A. Lightly incorporate ingredients into rice.

Looking to get your own MyNumber Card?

To get your own MyNumber Card, you must apply for one using the application form (交付申請書 koufu shinseisho) that came with your MyNumber Notification Card. If you do not have an application form, please contact us at Seika Town Office to get one. If you wish to apply for a MyNumber Card in person at Seika Town Office, be sure to bring an official piece of identification with you (driver's license, resident card, etc.).

The Many Ways to Apply...

★ Apply with your smartphone!

Scan the QR code at the bottom of the application form to start the application process on your smartphone. Be sure you have a face picture at the ready to send with your application when you are finished.



★ Apply on your computer!

Input your application ID on the MyNumber Card portal site to start the process on your computer. Upload a face picture to go on your card at the end of the application. (URL: https://kojinbango-card.go.jp/kofunshinse-pc/)

★ Apply by mail!

Fill out the application form, attach an appropriate face picture, and mail your application to us.

★ Apply in person at Seika Town Office!

An official piece of personal identification (driver's license, resident card, etc.) is required to apply for a MyNumber Card in person. A face picture for your MyNumber Card can be taken free of charge when applying at the Town Office.

Pick up your card at the Town Office when it's ready!

Approximately one month after applying, you will receive a notification saying that your new MyNumber card is available for pick up at Seika Town Office (交付通知書 koufu tsuuchi-sho). An appointment is required to pick up your card, so be sure to make one ahead of time by contacting Seika Town Office.

MyNumber Weekend Reception (by appointment only)

The MyNumber weekend reception window is open during certain weekends and accepts MyNumber Card applications, pick-up appointments, and digital certificate updates. An appointment is required to use the weekend reception window.

- ★ The MyNumber Weekend Reception window is open on 1/15, 1/30, 2/12, and 2/27. You must make an appointment to receive service.
 - Operating Hours: 9:00 11:45 a.m. and 1:00 4:45 p.m.
 - Appointments can be made by phone (0774-95-1915) or e-mail.



Information Regarding Special Cash Payments to Families with Children



Last year on November 19, the cabinet of the Japanese government decided to distribute 10,000 yen per child to families with children under 18 to combat the economic effects the coronavirus has had on families raising children. In response to this, Seika Town will distribute 10,000 per child to families living in Seika Town.

★ Eligible People

- Children who were eligible to receive Child Allowance (jidou teate) in 2021 September
- 2. Children who were high school students as of 2021 Sept. 30 (children born 2003 Apr. 2 2006 Apr. 1) X Parent/guardian income must be equal to or less than amount eligible for Child Allowance
- 3. Children who were born 2021 Oct. 1 2022 Mar. 31 that are eligible for Child Allowance

★ Payment Recipient Eligibility

The parent or guardian of a child deemed eligible by the stipulations above that earns the most in the household (whoever receives Child Allowance payments) will be eligible to receive the payment.

★ Payment Amount

10,000 yen per eligible child (lump-sum)

★ Payment Distribution Method

1. People who received Child Allowance in 2021 September

The payment will be deposited into the same account that received Child Allowance payment for 2021 Sept.

2. Parents or guardians that apply for the payment

The payment will be deposited into the account specified on the application by the applicant.

★ How to Apply to Receive the Payment

1. People who received Child Allowance in 2021 Sept.

Recipients of Child Allowance for 2021 Sept. do not need to apply to receive the payment. Documents regarding the payment were sent to applicable households at the beginning of December.

2. People who are raising children and are not (1) under "Eligible People"

Potential recipients who do not fall under category 1 as described under "Eligible People" must apply to receive the payment. Applications were sent at the end of December to potentially eligible households. Please apply before the deadline if you would like to receive the special payment. If you have not received the application but are eligible to receive the payment, please contact the Child Rearing Support Division at Seika Town Office (kosodate shien-ka)

* Application Deadline

Applications will be accepted 2022 Jan. 7 - Mar. 31.

Please apply for the payment before the deadline. Applications received after the deadline has passed will not be processed, and the applicant will not receive any payment.

★ Payment Deposit Date

1. People who received Child Allowance in 2021 Sept.

Payments for people who received Child Allowance in 2021 Sept. were deposited on Dec. 24.

2. People who are raising children and are not (1) under "Eligible People"

Payments for applicants will be deposited as applications are processed.

- · Applications turned in by the 20th of each month may have money deposited by the end of the month
- Deposits for applications turned in before the acceptance start date will happen by the end of January at the earliest.
