RESIDENCY AND TAX CERTIFICATES FROM CONVENIENCE STORE DISTRIBUTION SERVICE

In addition to residency certificates, convenience stores will now start distributing family registry certificates (permanent residence certificates) and tax certificates (certificate of earnings and tax declaration/exemption certificates) starting November 1.

To Receive the Service

You must register your My Number Card and register for the Convenience store distribution service (User Electronic Certification). If you have already picked up your My Number Card there is no need to register again. However, when you go to register your card, there is a possibility that it will be deemed unnecessary and in those cases you will not be able to use it.

People who Can Pick Up Certificates and Fees

- All family registry documents and permanent residence certificates— Seika residents, 450 yen. Address and family registry address must be Seika and can be picked up until the end of October.


