Cooperating with the National Census

This fall, the 2015 National Census will be taking place throughout the country. Its purpose is to confirm the status all people currently residing in Japan.

This year Census responses can also be completed online as well. On the 10th of September (Thu), Census volunteers will go to each house and distribute information on how to submit a response online. Responses must be completed by the 20th of September (Sun). For houses that did not submit a response, a regular paper response form will be distributed to each house between the 26th (Sat) and 30th (Wed) of September. Census volunteers will come by between the 1st (Thu) and the 7th (Wed) of October to collect responses, but they can also be sent by mail. The results of the Census will be used for different plans regarding Social Welfare, employment, lifestyle and disaster prevention. Participation in the census is also required by law. Your "My Number" Info Card Will Be Sent Next Month

If for some reason you will not be able to receive your "My Number" Info Card at your home address, you (absolutely) must register your current location at the Town Office General Reception Division (2nd Fl.) by the 25th (Fri) of September.

However, in some cases, even if you register you still cannot have your card sent to where you are living. For more information, consult the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications website or contact the division listed below.

People that need to register your current location are:

- People who are victims of Domestic Violence, Stalking, Child Abuse, etc. and as a result are living somewhere else.
- People affected by the Tohoku Earthquake that are living in a different residence now.
- People currently hospitalized or residing in a medical facility.
